

BY-LAW NUMBER 32-2022

OF

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRANTFORD

By-law to amend Chapter 478 (Signs – Outdoor – Other Advertising Devices) of the City of Brantford Municipal Code

WHEREAS Committee of the Whole – Community Development, at its meeting on April 3, 2018, considered Staff Report CD2018-024 titled “Proposed Amendments to the Sign By-law (Chapter 478 of the Municipal Code) Concerning Billboards and Heritage Properties”; and

WHEREAS Council ratified an amended resolution which directed, among other matters, that references to the word “should” in the draft by-law attached to Report CD2018-024 be changed “from ‘should’ to ‘shall’ as appropriate”; and

WHEREAS By-law 51-2018 was subsequently passed by Council on April 24, 2018 to amend Chapter 478 of the Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS it has since been discovered that a reference to the word “should” was not changed to “shall” in Clause 3.1 of Appendix 1 to By-law 51-2018;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRANTFORD ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Chapter 478 of the City of Brantford Municipal Code is hereby amended by striking out the word “should” in Clause 3.1 of Schedule ‘B’ – Guidelines – Heritage Buildings and inserting the word “shall” in its place.
2. THAT this By-law comes into force on the date of its passing.
