BY-LAW NUMBER 32-2022

OF

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRANTFORD

By-law to amend Chapter 478 (Signs – Outdoor – Other Advertising Devices) of the City of Brantford Municipal Code

WHEREAS Committee of the Whole – Community Development, at its meeting on April 3, 2018, considered Staff Report CD2018-024 titled "Proposed Amendments to the Sign By-law (Chapter 478 of the Municipal Code) Concerning Billboards and Heritage Properties"; and

WHEREAS Council ratified an amended resolution which directed, among other matters, that references to the word "should" in the draft by-law attached to Report CD2018-024 be changed "from 'should' to 'shall' as appropriate"; and

WHEREAS By-law 51-2018 was subsequently passed by Council on April 24, 2018 to amend Chapter 478 of the Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS it has since been discovered that a reference to the world "should" was not changed to "shall" in Clause 3.1 of Appendix 1 to By-law 51-2018;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRANTFORD ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT Chapter 478 of the City of Brantford Municipal Code is hereby amended by striking out the word "should" in Clause 3.1 of Schedule 'B' Guidelines Heritage Buildings and inserting the word "shall" in its place.
- 2. THAT this By-law comes into force on the date of its passing.
