

BY-LAW NUMBER 52-2022
OF
THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRANTFORD

Being a By-law to Repeal portions of By-law 259-2021 and to Establish Municipal Code Chapter 120 (Indigenous Affairs Advisor – Appointment)

WHEREAS City Council at its meeting held December 21, 2021 adopted By-law 259-2021, being a By-law regarding the Indigenous Affairs Advisor Position; and

WHEREAS Lucas Isaacs was hired as the City's Indigenous Affairs Advisor;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRANTFORD HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Paragraphs 1, 2, 3, and 4 of By-law 259-2021 are hereby repealed.
2. THAT Chapter 120 (Indigenous Affairs Advisor – Appointment) be added to the City of Brantford Municipal Code in the form as attached hereto as Appendix A.

Appendix “A”

Chapter 120

INDIGENOUS AFFAIRS ADVISOR – APPOINTMENT

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Article 1

APPOINTMENT

120.1.1 Indigenous Affairs Advisor – Appointment – Lucas Isaacs

Lucas Isaacs is hereby appointed Indigenous Affairs Advisor of The Corporation of the City of Brantford.

Article 2

AUTHORITY – DUTIES

120.2.1 Authority – Duties

The Indigenous Affairs Advisor shall serve as an employee of the municipality, with general responsibility for the provision of advice and recommendations to the municipal Council of the City of Brantford, and its administrative staff, in relation to Indigenous matters. Such advice and recommendations shall be given either upon request or at the initiative of the Indigenous Affairs Advisor.

120.2.2 Meetings

The Indigenous Affairs Advisor shall have access to Council as necessary in order to fulfill his/her responsibilities pursuant to this by-law. Such meetings shall be arranged in accordance with the City's Procedure By-law and must also be attended by the Chief Administrative Officer, the City Solicitor, and the City Clerk pursuant to requirements of the *Municipal Act 2001*, S.O. 2001 c. 25, as amended from time to time.

Article 3

REPORTING RELATIONSHIP

120.3.1 Reporting Relationship

The Indigenous Affairs Advisor shall form part of the Chief Administrative Officer's office for administrative purposes and, except where such reporting would be contrary to any provision of this Chapter, the Indigenous Affairs Advisor shall report to the Chief Administrative Officer and shall be subject to his/her direction.

120.3.2 Exception

In giving advice to Council and in performing other services to Council where such services have been specifically requested of the Indigenous Affairs Advisor by Council from time to time by by-law, resolution, or other written instrument which has been passed at a meeting at which a majority of the members of Council present have approved the request, the Indigenous Affairs Advisor shall not be subject to the direction of any administrative staff of the municipality but shall report directly to Council.

Article 4

FINANCIAL

120.4.1 Financial

The Indigenous Affairs Advisor shall be paid for his services in accordance with the salary grid established pursuant to the Exempt Employee Group Wage/Salary Administration Policy.
