- C. THAT staff BE DIRECTED to work with the Grand River Conservation Authority and the County of Brant to investigate options for continuing programming at Apps' Mill.

- C. THAT "Lane Designation" BE APPROVED on Icomm Drive at Clarence Street South as outlined in Appendix "A" of this report; and
