

BY-LAW NUMBER 197-2023
OF
THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRANTFORD

To amend By-law Number 144-88, being a by-law to regulate
Parking in the City of Brantford

WHEREAS By-law 177-2019, enacting Public Works-021 Policy to Amend On-Street Parking Regulations was approved by City Council on November 19, 2019; and

WHEREAS the policy permits Parking By-law Amendments meeting specific criteria to be placed before City Council without first being considered by Committee of the Whole – Operations; and

WHEREAS the following amendments meet the criteria of Public Works-021 Policy and will allow for improvement and better regulation of parking within the City of Brantford;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRANTFORD ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Colonial Crescent – Parking Prohibited at Anytime

- a) THAT Schedule “7” of Parking By-law 144-88 which pertains to “Parking Prohibited at Anytime” BE AMENDED to provide the following:

<u>NAME OF STREET</u>	<u>SIDE OF STREET</u>	<u>LOCATION WHERE PARKING PROHIBITED</u>
Colonial Crescent	North	From a point 49 metres south of the centre line of Skylark Road (west intersection) for a distance of 27 metres southwesterly.
Colonial Crescent	South	From a point 128 metres south west of the centre line of Skylark Road (west intersection) for a distance of 22 metres southerly.
Colonial Crescent	North	From a point 98 metres south of the centre line of Skylark Road (east intersection) for a distance of 32 metres southwesterly.
Colonial Crescent	North	From a point 215 metres south west of the centre line of Skylark Road (east intersection) for a distance of 31 metres southwesterly.

2. THAT this by-law shall become effective upon the date of its passing, save and except that any provisions of this by-law affecting traffic on highways designated as connecting links, pursuant to Subsection 195(3) of The Highway Traffic Act, as amended, and Subsection 21(1) of The Public Transportation and Highway Improvement Act, as amended, shall not become operative until approved by the Ontario Ministry of Transportation.
