

BY-LAW NUMBER 209-2023

OF

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRANTFORD

By-law to amend By-law 70-2010, being a By-law to adopt various City of Brantford Policies, by amending Corporate Policy – 010 (Delegation of Authority Policy).

WHEREAS per Section 8(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended (the “Act”), the powers of a municipality shall be interpreted broadly so as to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it consider appropriate and to enhance the municipality’s ability to respond to municipal issues; and

WHEREAS at its meeting on June 7, 2010, City Council passed By-law 70-2010, being a By-law to adopt various policies of the City of Brantford and to create a Corporate Policy Manual, which policies are attached as Appendix “A” to By-law 70-2010; and

WHEREAS at its meeting held on December 19, 2023, City Council adopted the recommendations set out in Item 12.3.5 of Committee of the Whole – Planning and Administration Report No. 2023-12-12 to make enhancements to the City of Brantford’s Heritage Grant Program;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRANTFORD ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT By-law 70-2010 is hereby amended by amending Item 23 of Schedule “B” – Documents – People, Legislated Services and Planning attached thereto as follows:

- a. The Terms, Conditions, Prerequisites or Other Conditions Which Must Be Satisfied Prior to Execution, which currently says:

“Approval of application in accordance with Heritage Grant Program requirements.

Grant must be within a Council-approved budget.

Written recommendation of the Manager of Long Range Planning, in consultation with the Brantford Heritage Committee.”

Be repealed and replaced with:

“Approval of application in accordance with Heritage Grant Program requirements.

Grant must be within a Council-approved budget.

Written recommendation of the Manager of Long Range Planning for major and minor grants, and in consultation with the Brantford Heritage Committee for major grants.”

2. THAT the Clerk be directed to update the Corporate Policy Manual to reflect the amendment to said Policy approved herein; and
3. This By-law comes into force on the date of its passing.
