Additional Information:

The original resident of Lawfield was James Kerr Osborne, who was involved with the company later known as Massey Ferguson in the City of Brantford. A Brantford Expositor article from 1890 described the design of the building as "modern in character and pleasing." A later owner of the property included A.D. Clement, a postmaster, who resided there in 1894. In the 1990s the Canadian Red Cross Society, another later owner, conducted renovations and repairs to the building. In 2002 the organization made alterations to the interior to accommodate the introduction of offices.
