Answer: A traffic study is to be completed as well as that the retirement building will not add a large amount of traffic especially during peak hours due to the fact it is retirement living

C: Are all units going to be rentals?

C: Can the plan be changed and putting the entrance onto Edmonson street

A: That property is not owned by the same owner and it would likely cause worse traffic issues

C: Is the building a retirement home or a rental?

C: Will it be constructed two years from now?

A: Most likely

C: Will there be enough parking?

C: Construction hours?

A: Hopefully the project is to be started by next fall, 1 year-14 months for construction
