## BY-LAW NUMBER 9-2021

OF

## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRANTFORD

## To amend Traffic By-law 37-83, being a by-law to regulate Traffic in the City of Brantford

WHEREAS Committee of the Whole – Operations and Administration of Council of the Corporation of the City of Brantford has recommended to Council for the improvement and better regulation of traffic within the City of Brantford; and

WHEREAS Council desires to implement the recommendations of the Committee as aforesaid;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRANTFORD ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. <u>Grey Street Designated Lanes for Bicycles</u>
- a) THAT Schedule "14" of Traffic By-law 37-83 which pertains to "Designated Lanes for Bicycles" BE REPEALED as follows:

<u>STREET</u>	<u>LIMITS</u>	<u>LANES</u>	TIMES OR DAYS
Grey Street	Between James Avenue and a point 129m west of Rowanwood Avenue	North, westbound adjacent to shoulder of roadway	Anytime
Grey Street	Between a point 129m west of Rowanwood Avenue and a point 48m west of Rowanwood Avenue	North, westbound adjacent to parking lane	Anytime
Grey Street	Between James Avenue and Rowanwood Avenue	South, eastbound adjacent to shoulder of roadway	Anytime

b) THAT Schedule "14" of Traffic By-law 37-83 which pertains to "Designated Lanes for Bicycles" BE AMENDED as follows:

<u>STREET</u>	<u>LIMITS</u>	<u>LANES</u>	TIMES OR DAYS
Grey Street	Between James Avenue and a point 48m west of Rowanwood Avenue	North, westbound adjacent to parking lane	Anytime
Grey Street	Between James Avenue and Rowanwood Avenue	South, eastbound adjacent to curb	Anytime

2. THAT this by-law shall become effective upon the date of its passing, save and except that any provisions of this by-law affecting traffic on highways designated as connecting links, pursuant to Subsection 195(3) of The Highway Traffic Act, as amended, and Subsection 21(1) of The Public Transportation and Highway Improvement Act, as amended, shall not become operative until approved by the Ontario Ministry of Transportation.
