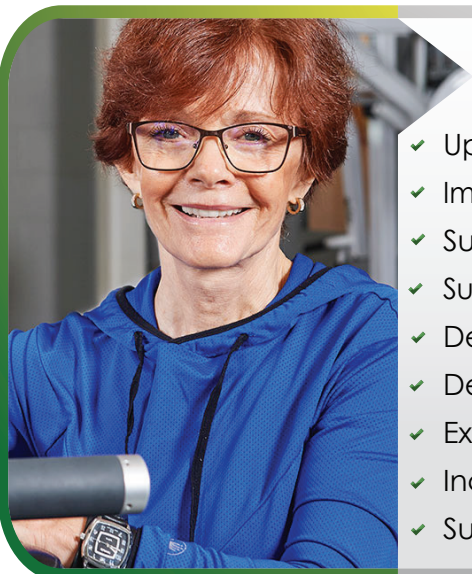
NEIGHBOURHOODS
