

BY-LAW NUMBER 187-2021

OF

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRANTFORD

To amend Traffic By-law 37-83, being a by-law to regulate
Traffic in the City of Brantford

WHEREAS Committee of the Whole – Operations and Administration of Council of the Corporation of the City of Brantford has recommended to Council for the improvement and better regulation of traffic within the City of Brantford; and

WHEREAS Council desires to implement the recommendations of the Committee as aforesaid;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRANTFORD ENACTS
AS FOLLOWS:

1. Morton Avenue at Grand Street – Traffic Control

- a) THAT Schedule “1” of Traffic By-law 37-83 which pertains to “Through Highways”
BE REPEALED as follows:

Morton Avenue	From the east side of North Park Street to the west side of West Street

- b) THAT Schedule “1” of Traffic By-law 37-83 which pertains to “Through Highways”
BE AMENDED to provide the following:

<u>THROUGH STREET</u>	<u>LIMITS</u>

Morton Avenue	From the east side of North Park Street to the west side of Grand Street

Morton Avenue	From the east side of Grand Street to the west side of Herbert Street

Morton Avenue	From the east side of Herbert Street to the west side of West Street

2. THAT this by-law shall become effective upon the date of its passing, save and except that any provisions of this by-law affecting traffic on highways designated as connecting links, pursuant to Subsection 195(3) of The Highway Traffic Act, as amended, and Subsection 21(1) of The Public Transportation and Highway Improvement Act, as amended, shall not become operative until approved by the Ontario Ministry of Transportation.
