3.0 Recommendation

- A. THAT report no. 2021-134 regarding “Housekeeping – Albion Street Parking Control By-laws” BE RECEIVED; and
- B. THAT Parking by-law 144-88, being a by-law to regulate Parking in the City of Brantford BE AMENDED; and
- C. THAT the necessary by-laws BE PRESENTED to Council for adoption.

4.0 Executive Summary

This report is to provide City Council with information on housekeeping updates to Parking by-law 144-88. The outcome will result in by-law schedules that are consistent with the current signage on Albion Street.

5.0 Purpose and Overview

To amend Parking by-law 144-88 to correct by-law schedules so they are consistent with existing parking signage.

6.0 Background

An omission occurred in Report 2021-211 which overlooked the removal of Time Exemption Permit parking on the west side of Albion Street. Report 2021-211 was a report to council in order to amend traffic and parking by-laws on Albion Street in order to create a safe, dedicated road space for bicycle lanes, permanent parking on the east side of the street, a consistent speed limit, and enhancements to transit stops to accommodate all road users. This report amends the by-law to remove the Time Exemption Permit parking on the west side of the street, but continues to permit Time Exemption Permit parking on the east side of the street in the designated on-street parking lane.

Additionally, this report cleans up the parking by-law by restricting parking on the west side of Albion Street from West Street to Bedford Street. Currently the by-law only restricts parking from West Street to Henrietta Street.

This report amends schedules in Parking by-law 144-88 so they are up to date with current conditions on City streets.

7.0 Corporate Policy Context

- A safe, efficient transportation system connects the community across neighbourhoods, with neighbouring communities and provincial transportation network.

9.0 Analysis

The Parking by-law 144-88 requires amending on Albion Street to continue to allow Time Limit Exemption Permit parking on the east side of the street, while removing Time Limit Exemption Permit parking on the west side of Albion Street.


The amendments to the above-noted schedules of Parking by-law 144-88 are attached in Appendix "A".
