- E. THAT the remaining funding in the amount of \$20,210 in the Vision Zero Road Safety capital project (CP2103) BE APPROVED to complete a communications campaign and community consultations regarding the locations of Community Safety Zones in support of Council Resolution *Community Safety Zones*, passed on June 22, 2021.
