SCOPE OF WORK FOR A HERITAGE PERMIT UNDER THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT APPLICATION NO. HA-08-21 LOCATION OF WORK: 175 BRANT AVENUE

Pursuant to the *Ontario Heritage Act*, By-law 148-2016 and By-law 70-2010 as amended, the following works were approved by the Planning Department of The Corporation of the City of Brantford under Delegated Authority, in accordance with the details filed in Application HA-08-21 and the approval by the Brantford Heritage Committee on October 25, 2021.

Alterations described in Application HA-08-21:

- Repointing of damaged and deteriorated mortar at various locations on all exterior walls.
- Remove and reconstruct chimney at south end of building with new bricks to match existing; reconstructed chimney to feature a corbel designed to match the chimney being removed.
- Remove chimney at rear of dwelling;
- Reconstruct exterior brick of rear bay-window knee wall to address deteriorating mortar and to realign brick sill.
